**Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015- Order received from Office of Collector of Stamps, Government of N.C.T. Delhi**

Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI LODR Regulations”), we wish to inform you that Company has received the orders (“Orders”) from the “Collector of Stamp, Government of N.C.T. of Delhi” in connection with the adjudication of stamp duty in relation to the issuance of certain shares by the Company in dematerialized form.

The matter has arisen pursuant to a circular issued during the year 2025 by the Additional District Magistrate, Collector of Stamps, Revenue Department, Delhi (“Delhi Revenue Department”), whereby the rate of stamp duty applicable to the issuance of dematerialized shares under the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, as amended pursuant to the Finance Act, 2019 and effective from July 01, 2020, has been disputed.

The Company has already filed writ petition before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi in connection with this issue and the proceedings are presently under judicial consideration. The Company clarifies that the Company had paid stamp duty on such issuance in accordance with section 9A (1) read with Article 56A of Schedule I of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899.

The necessary disclosures required pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Master Circular No. HO/49/14/14(7)2025-CFD-POD2/I/3762/2026 dated January 30, 2026 is attached as **Annexure**.
